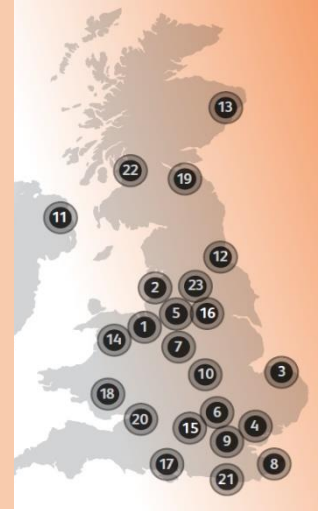


Council for Allied Health Professions Research (CAHPR)
